

School Teacher info sheet 2017

- To book your trip and your Safety Visit, email snowschool@skiwentworth.ca or call (902) 548-2089 ext. 229.
- An alphabetical list of ALL students and chaperone's names are required.
- This list must be emailed or faxed before you leave the school to rentalshop@skiwentworth.ca or (902)548-2611 Attn: Rental Shop.
- Please advise us if any children require special attention or needs(as we may need special instructors to work with them)
- If you are unable to make your ski trip please call and advise us. Please call or email us with any changes.
- To speed up the process, Tickets can be pre-printed before the school arrives by calling ahead the morning of the visit. (902) 548-2089 Ext 233
- Upon arrival, the trip organizer should proceed directly to the rental shop. Students are to remain on the bus until welcomed by a Wentworth Instructor. Trip organizer must purchase all lift tickets and rental equipment for students, chaperones and teachers. School rates are only given to those people who are on the school list and only for school kids with the booked school.
- When renting skis, students are required to know height, weight, shoe size and skier ability for the binding settings on their skis.
- Helmets are mandatory for everyone in Nova Scotia. There are helmets available for all students.
- Once the students have all their gear they must be fully dressed and proceed to bunny hill. All bags are to be left in main lodge area.
- Students are not allowed on black diamond trails, half pipe, woods, terrain parks, or closed trails.
- All students will be assessed by a Wentworth Instructor before proceeding to the main hill. A Wentworth Instructor will accompany all students on their first run on the main hill unless otherwise instructed by Snow School. Beginners will have a lesson. Not all beginners will make it up the chairlift on their first visit. Our Instructors will only let those students up the chairlift if we feel they are ready. This should be mentioned to all parents and kids before they arrive or take part in the trip.
- For safety reasons, there is no trading of equipment.
- Teachers and Chaperones must help in the rental shop put boots on and make sure all students have a lift ticket on their jacket and the kids are properly dressed. Teachers and parents will be advised by staff at the rental shop where they are needed to help out.

- Teachers and Chaperones must be 19yr old to receive complimentary tickets, and everyone must sign the waiver form, teachers and Chaperones will get there tickets and gear after kids all have theirs. Student ratio for free tickets for Chaperones is 1:8 students
